SOUTH BAY MATH CIRCLE RULES AND EXPECTATIONS

By joining the South Bay Math Circle students and parents agree to abide the following rules:

- 1. COME ON TIME: All the classes have various start time. It is student's responsibility to observe the start time for the class they are attending. We strongly discourage late arrivals since they are very disruptive to the sessions.
- 2. COME PREPARED: Bring a folder dedicated to the South Bay Math Circle materials. You will be putting worksheets and packets into this folder. The packets are due the following meeting. Bring scratch paper. Bring pencils and erasers. Middle school students need to bring a calculator. Make your best effort in completing problems assigned for homework. More than 3 incomplete homework packets, students will be drop from the class.
- 3. BEHAVIOR RULES: No cell phones or electronic games are allowed during class time. Calculators are allowed only in sessions when instructors have asked to bring them. No running and playing in the classrooms. Follow the instructions of mentors. Be engaged in the classroom activities (no working on outside projects or homework; no cell phones; no playing games; no reading of outside materials). Maintain classroom environment conductive of learning (be respectful to the mentors, your peers; stay in your seat; do not speak out of turn). Be careful with the furniture and classroom equipment, as well as when using any library facilities. Clean up your work space before leaving the classroom.
- 4. FOR PARENTS: Parents (except for specially designated room parents) are generally not allowed in the classrooms during the math circle sessions. Please stay with your children until the session starts. Please sign in and sign out your child on the sign in/out sheets provided next to the Purcell Room of the library. Conversation outside the classroom should be kept to a minimum. Please pick up your child promptly at the end of the math circle sessions.
